Kateri wasn't clear how much the rent per space is. Hannah Cain generously donated the cost for 2 garden spaces. The space, water and seeds are all provided. We will want to promote the open spaces to the residents for their usage. Other current activities include chair yoga which is every other Monday and volunteers who are helping with Tax Aide program.

Treasurer Report – Jan provided the monthly financials.
